John 16:1 "I have told you these things so that you won't fall away. **2** For you will be expelled from the synagogues, and the time is coming when those who kill you will think they are doing God a service. **3** This is because they have never known the Father or me. **4** Yes, I'm telling you these things now, so that when they happen, you will remember I warned you. I didn't tell you earlier because I was going to be with you for a while longer.

D The Grief will come before joy (16-24)

John 16:16 “In just a little while I will be gone, and you won’t see me anymore. Then, just a little while after that, you will see me again.” **17** The disciples asked each other, “What does he mean when he says, ‘You won’t see me, and then you will see me’? And what does he mean when he says, ‘I am going to the Father’? **18** And what does he mean by ‘a little while’? We don’t understand.”

John 16:19 Jesus realized they wanted to ask him, so he said, “Are you asking yourselves what I meant? I said in just a little while I will be gone, and you won’t see me anymore. Then, just a little while after that, you will see me again. **20** Truly, you will weep and mourn over what is going to happen to me, but the world will rejoice. You will grieve, but your grief will suddenly turn to wonderful joy when you see me again. **21** It will be like a woman experiencing the pains of labor. When her child is born, her anguish gives place to joy because she has brought a new person into the world. **22** You have sorrow now, but I will see you again; then you will rejoice, and no one can rob you of that joy. **23** At that time you won’t need to ask me for anything. The truth is, you can go directly to the Father and ask him, and he will grant your request because you use my name. **24** You haven’t done this before. Ask, using my name, and you will receive, and you will have abundant joy.

From this we believe that you came from God.”
